Dear **59 For The Future** Mentor,

We are delighted that you have agreed to serve as a Mentor for your Chapter's **59 For The Future** Scholar. We appreciate your willingness to support the intellectual capacity of the brightest students in the Western Area while they develop into thought leaders and change agents, learning about local, national, and international issues that affect the global community.

The Scholars will complete three Issues Modules during the Spring 2019 cohort, which begins the week of January 7 and ends May 3, 2019. The Modules will focus on topics of current global significance and provide opportunities for strategic thinking, research and writing through use of an online platform. TED Talks will be modeled in student-produced videos of their perspectives on global issues.

We ask that you provide encouragement, support and relevant feedback to the Scholar. We also ask that you commit to the following specific responsibilities for the program:

- Maintain consistent communication with the Scholar and serve as the Scholar's liaison to the Chapter.
- Assess if the student can handle the workload of the program including her schoolwork and extracurricular activities.
- Verify the student has accessibility to a computer and video recording materials.
- Consistently communicate expectations of scholarly excellence to the Scholar, including the commitment of 10 hours to complete each Module.
- Ensure the required learning experiences occur by encouraging the Scholar to read, research, think and write critically.
- Facilitate the Scholar's competencies of listening to others, demonstrating empathy, modeling self-directed behaviors, and communicating with the cohort of Scholars.
- Review video presentation for sound and visual look before submitting to the 59FTF Committee. Facilitate presentation to the Chapter by the Scholar on one of the issues they will be required to video; encourage Chapter supportive feedback on the presentation.
- If Scholar misses a deadline, be proactive in helping the Scholar get back on schedule.
